Description

Sovereign Hey'di Barrier Mortar is a hydrophobic, non-shrinking repair mortar. It is an integral part of the Sovereign Hey'di K11 Tanking System, used to create a fillet at wall/wall and wall/floor junctures.

Form Supplied: Powder Pack Sizes: 25 Kg Colour range: Grey

Contains: Cement and additives

Properties

Form a water resistant mortar that does not shrink and has excellent adhesion to concrete and mortar. Can be used as a general repair mortar where shrinkage must be avoided. Barrier Mortar has a long pot life, typically 5 hours ensuring that wastage is kept to a minimum.

Usage

Barrier mortar should be applied to a damp substrate. When using with the K11 system apply a 25 mm fillet into all vertical and horizontal joints. It should be applied onto the first coat of K11 before it has cured. This will typically be around 1 hour application of the K11, and care should be taken not to damage the underlying coating.

Allow the barrier mortar to stiffen for 2-3 hours and then apply the second coat of K11 to the substrate and over the Barrier Mortar.

Barrier Mortar can also be used as a general repair compound for patch filling of masonry wall and floors. When cured it has a compressive strength of >40N/mm². Do not use in temperatures below 5°C.

Coverage

When used as a 25 mm fillet around 1 kg per linear metre will be required. When used as a repair compound 25 kg mixed with water will produce around 15 litres of mortar.

Shelf Life

12 months when stored unopened and above ground in cool dry conditions.
